

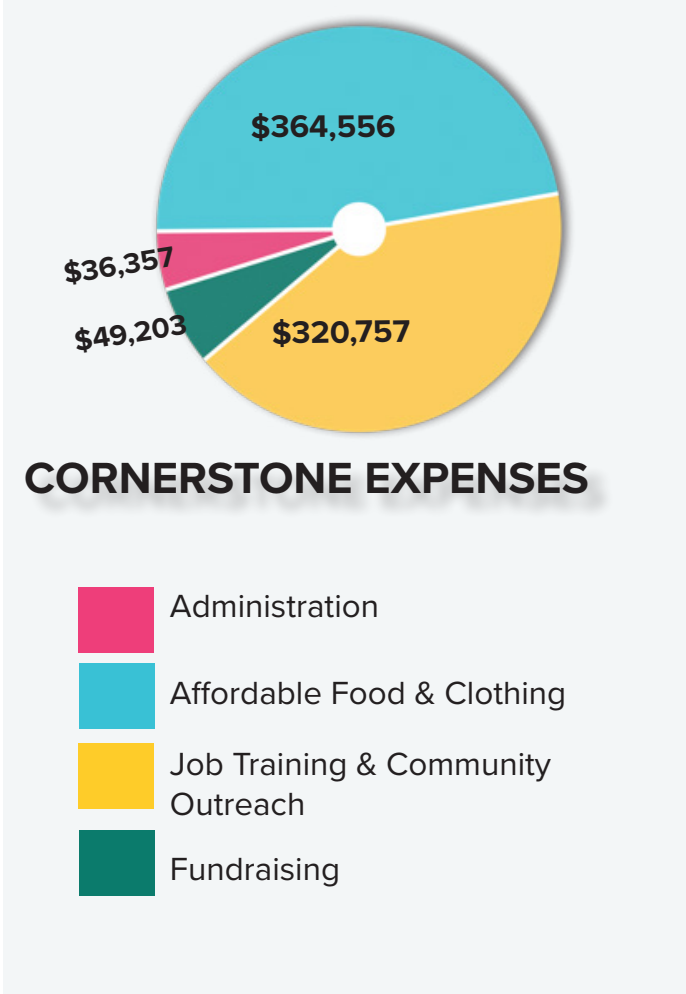


# 2017 IMPACT REPORT

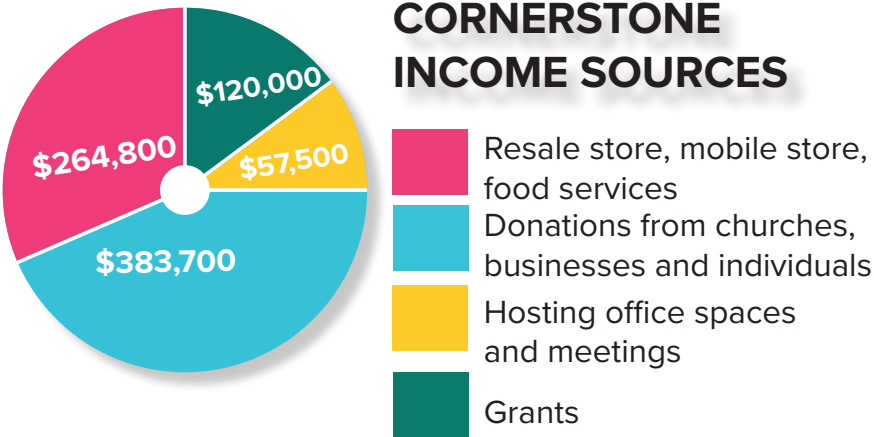

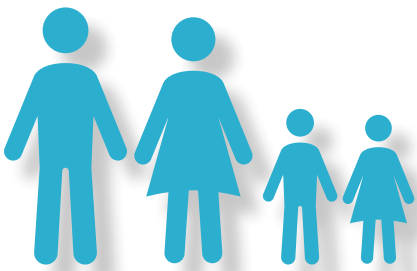


## CORNERSTONE INCOME SOURCES

## RENT ASSISTANCE

Dispersed some **\$85,000** in funds to prevent families from becoming homeless.



## CWJC

Provided career clothing for more than **150** graduates of Christian Women's Job Corps.

We partnered with more than **40** churches to meet the needs of East Texans.



## CORNERSTONE RESALE STORE

Cornerstone Resale & Donation Center tracked over **150,000** transactions in 2017, helping families by providing affordable clothing, household items and necessities.

Cornerstone works with other nonprofits by offering discounted school uniforms and Christmas toys to their clients.

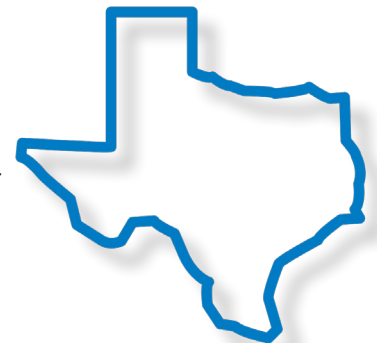


## MOBILE SALES
